1800.46 BOARDING SCHOOL -

A student Any out-of-state student who transfers to become a full-time resident of a Colorado 24-hour boarding school (a duly licensed school providing lodging and meals) in a community, district or state other than where he/she has resided with his/her parent(s) or guardians, has varsity eligibility on the first such transfer, but all transfer rule requirements shall apply on any subsequent transfer.

RATIONALE: Allows for transfer of out-of-state students to a CO boarding school, but not from in-

state, so as not to bypass the intent of the  $\mbox{\it bylaw}$ 

PROS: Clear interpretation for membership as to how transfers to boarding schools will be handled.

Transfer bylaws are in effect with subsequent moves.

CONS: None.
