1800.42	NON-PARTICIPATION - A student who has not participated in an interscholastic practice , contest, scrimmage, or foundation game in a specific sport at any level (varsity, junior varsity, sophomore, and freshman) during the 365 days preceding the date of transfer shall have varsity eligibility at the receiving school in that specific sport at all levels of competition.

1800.43 RETURN TO ORIGINAL SCHOOL - A student who has not participated in an interscholastic **practice**, contest, scrimmage, or foundation game for any team at any level while a student in the previous high school shall be varsity eligible at all levels in all sports provided he/she returns to the high school he/she attended prior to the period of non-participation.

RATIONALE: Tightens up the transfer rule so that students cannot practice a day or several days at a school, get cut, and then transfer with full eligibility to another school, or back to their original school.

PROS: Provides a consistent interpretation for all students – whether or not they are fall, winter, or spring athletes.

CONS: A tighter transfer rule to restrict participation at the new school if they have practiced at another school prior to transfering.
