A spirit team, for the purpose of this Bylaw, shall include all of the following who represent their school in cheer, co-ed, pom pon, jazz, **game day**, and hip-hop.

(POADD OF DIDECTORS)

RATIONALE: On game day, it is the spirit program's primary role to support their school's athletic teams and create a positive atmosphere around the game. They do this by using a combination of crowd-effective chants and skills to rally the crowd, communicate to fans and support the athletes on the field to create a home field advantage.
