no The top eight teams in 5A football will move into a 6A playoff bracket. The top eight teams that are identified will have a bye week following the end of the regular season and the beginning of the playoff bracket. The next sixteen teams identified by the final RPI Rankings (9-24) will qualify for the 5A playoff bracket.

Rationale:
