I. MAJOR CHANGES FROM LAST YEAR'S REPORT:

A. A presentation was made by Jerry Sisneros, retired coach, to provide a framed bracket for regionals and state tournaments. The committee approved the presentation of these awards for weight class winners provided that costs were met and the awards were not mandated. Options for funding the awards included the search for a sponsor, regional host could pay for the costs, or the participating schools can agree to cover the costs at their expense.

II. RATIONALE:

A. The committee did not want to mandate anything that would increase costs to schools but did want to provide flexibility to provide regional hosts to do something similar that is happening in other sports at the same level.

III. FINANCIAL IMPACT:

A. The increase in costs in only the costs that the reginal host is willing to incur individually or what the participating schools agree to by vote. These costs are not allowable CHSAA costs in the financial report for the contest.

A. Girl's only wrestling invitational dates will be sent to schools and posted on CHSAANOW.com prior to the season so that teams may plan in advance.

- B. By 9:00 p.m. on Thursday night during the week of the regional tournament, regional site directors will release a list of all seeded wrestlers by weight class to the coaches for review of accuracy and to request necessary changes prior to Friday's weigh-ins.
- C. Weight assessments may be performed beginning Wednesday, November 1, 2019. All wrestlers must have a completed weight assessment prior to competition.
- D. Dress Code: During the regional and state tournaments coaches are required to wear full length pants (khaki's preferred), a collared shirt or a school issued shirt with school name or logo (collar preferred) and athletic shoes or dress shoes. All apparel must be in good repair. No hats, shorts or flip-flops are permitted.
